The story comes from an event that the writer Roger Smith happened onto one day in his head when he thought about how people overcome complications and emotional hardships through the spirit of forgiveness.

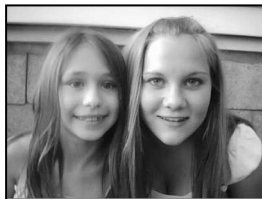
STORYLINE

OUR CREW
